

Portrait / Figure Workshop Instructor: Tom Root


In this three-day workshop, we'll draw and paint from the nude/partially draped model in Tom's Johnson City studio. Tom will demonstrate "seeing" techniques and painting methods, and will discuss general aspects of anatomy and how to think structurally about the figure. The workshop will include shorter poses for drawing and longer, multi-day poses for painting. This workshop is designed for intermediate to advanced adult students and professionals.

Studio Drawing and Painting (10 week session)

Level - Beginners to Advanced Classes are designed for adults, but serious teen students are welcome. Schedule is subject to change due to instructor schedules.

Thursday morning class (Johnson City Studio) Begins January 19th, 2017.

This course is designed to help the student become a skilled practitioner of freehand drawing and basic oil painting. Participants will work on upright easels, drawing from still life, casts, drapery and reproductions of master drawings, and will be instructed in various aspects of drawing such as likeness, light and shade, line, tone, massing, form, space, perspective and design. Painting is taught starting with limited palette and progressing to full color. Independent study is also an option in this class time. Instructor: **Tom Root**

9:00-12:00 (3 hour) Thursday Mornings - \$300 (drop-ins \$35 per class--call to see if there is space available.)

Suggested Materials: vine charcoal: 1 pkg. hard, 1 pkg. soft; sandpaper block; kneaded rubber eraser; chamois; backing board; Canson Ingres charcoal paper, full sheets, white and gray; sketchbook; soft drawing pencils. Oil painting materials will be recommended to individual students based on instructor's assessment. Please contact instructor at rootsudioschool@gmail.com.

Drawing Foundations with Allison Parker

Join <u>Allison Parker</u> for this weekly three-hour class in drawing fundamentals. This class offers a step-by step guide to academic drawing practices, giving the student a toolbox of skills to solve basic problems of proportion, structure, and dimension. Students will complete drawing exercises from simple plaster casts and master copies, offering the opportunity to slow down and focus on technique. Topics to be discussed will include measuring, the envelope method, shape-seeing, shading and proportion. Perfect for beginners or more experienced artists who want to refine their accuracy skills.

Beginning Painting

Allison Parker - Instructor

Tuesday evenings from 5 - 8 pm at the Jonesborough Studio \$ 350 for a 10 week term

Allison Parker will instruct Beginning Painting, recommended for those with previous drawing experience. (The Foundations Drawing course is recommended but not required.) This course will help students make the transition from black-and-white drawing to painting in color.

We will explore several strategies to make this transition easier, helping the student develop his or her own 'best' process leading to a finished piece. We will use several types of preparatory studies and discuss how to finish or develop paintings in situations where live observation time is limited.

Students will learn how to:

Create a preparatory drawing study for the painting
Use monochromatic underpainting techniques effectively
Plan and mix color schemes

Plan a small 'alla prima' color study

Finish a painting from a combination of preparatory studies and live observation.
