Portrait / Figure Workshop


In this three-day workshop, we'll draw and paint from nude and draped model in Tom's Johnson City studio. Tom will demonstrate "seeing" techniques and painting methods, and will discuss how to think structurally about the portrait/figure, treating it as one continuous form revealed by light. We will start each day with shorter poses for drawing and then move on to a longer multi-day pose for painting, where the concentration will be on developing the portrait/figure as an artful composition. This workshop is designed for intermediate to advanced adult students and professionals. The instructor will work on an ongoing demonstration during the long pose and also individually teach and critique each student. Price of the workshop is \$350 (including model fee). This workshop will be held upstairs in Tom's north light studio (Miller Artz Building across from Hands On Museum) at 316 East Main Street, Johnson City.
